However, their policies pushing for privatization, PPPs and austerity measures ultimately undermine the access to healthcare for people who need public services the most.

Our policy brief outlines recommendations to ensure that economic policies do not compromise access to public health.

These recommendations include negotiating more flexible loan conditions and ensuring the protection of social spending during periods of fiscal consolidation.
